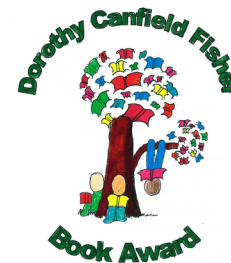

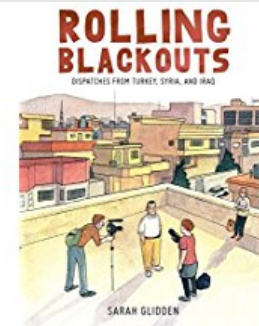


## Green Mountain Book Award List for High School Students
