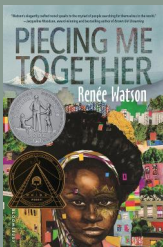
April is National School Library Month

Author Jason Reynolds speaks out for school libraries.



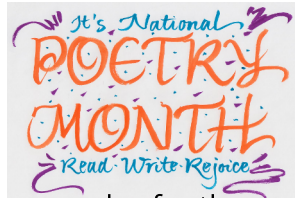
New Books Here In The Library Ready For You To Read Now
